

Platte Canyon Community Partnership (PCCP) Resale Boutique Judy Redline Service Scholarship Guidelines

- ✓ Scholarships are available to high school seniors who reside in the general boundaries between Shawnee and Conifer and/or attend Platte Canyon High School or Conifer High School.
- ✓ Information is made available through local high school counselors, in the Resale Boutique, and through local and social media.
- ✓ It is the responsibility of the student to sign up to be a volunteer in the Resale Boutique and commit to at least 20 hours of volunteer time to be eligible for a scholarship. Volunteer hours must be completed prior to submitting the scholarship application.
- ✓ Students may begin volunteering any time during their high school years to accrue cumulative hours.
- ✓ All scholarship paperwork is kept in the PCCP HS Scholarship binder.
- ✓ The student will sign in/out in the PCCP Scholarship binder as well as on the regular volunteer sign-in/out sheet with "HS" behind their name.
- ✓ In addition, regular volunteer forms to fill out: PCCP Volunteer Application, Procedures and Policies Acknowledgement, Liability Release and Parental Consent if under 18.
- ✓ The student will complete a general PCCP volunteer orientation during which they will receive
 the Scholarship Guidelines and a Scholarship Application.
- ✓ Students will complete the scholarship application and return it to the Resale Boutique by: September 1.
- ✓ Monetary awards are determined by acceptance to college, junior college or trade school, accrued volunteer hours, evaluation of required essays and general attitude and accomplishments while volunteering.
- ✓ The PCCP Board of Directors makes the selection and monetary decisions.
- ✓ The monetary award will go directly to the post-secondary institution.
